## Community Pharmacy Information Standard

### V3.01.03

Publication Date: August 2023

Previous Release: V3.01 June 2023

#### 1. Detailed implementation guidance changes

The detailed implementation guidance in the information model has been updated as detailed below:

- Clinical Summary > Clinical Narrative.
  - Guidance added to this element: *"This item should be used to capture "Professional discussions undertaken" where needed."*
- Contacts with Professionals > Contacts with Professionals Record Entry > Outcome of Contact.
  - Additional guidance added to include more valueset options for different CPCF services (text in bold is new to this release): *"Use NHS data dictionary if the service specification requires outcome of contact for secondary use data only. Otherwise use the following SNOMED CT: 3780001 |Routine patient disposition, no follow-up planned (procedure)| AND 896511000000107 |Follow-up appointment offered (situation)| AND 183616001 |Follow-up arranged (finding)|". **Some services have specific outcomes which should be included in the valueset when the clinician is carrying out that service:***

#### **New Medicine Service**

1. **"No action needed"**
2. **"Pharmacist and patient agree solution"**
3. **"Referral to GP practice for review"**
4. **"Referral to other prescribing organisation"**
5. **"Patient requires/requests Additional Follow up"**

#### **Contraception**

1. **"Supply Made"**
2. **"Supply Made & Referred/Signposted"**
3. **"No Supply - Clinically inappropriate & Referred/Signposted"**
4. **"No Supply - Declined by Patient"**
5. **"No supply - Escalated"**
6. **"No Supply - Other reason (please state)"**

### Discharge Medicine Service

1. "Advice provided on medicines regimen and questions answered"
2. "Onward referral"
3. "Other CPCF service provided"

### Community Pharmacist Consultation Service

1. "Advice given only"
2. "Sale of an Over the Counter (OTC) medicine"
3. "Referral into a pharmacy local minor ailments service (MAS)"
4. "Referral into an appropriate locally commissioned NHS service, such as a patient group direction"
5. "Medicines supply / non-supply"
6. "Onward referral to another CPCS pharmacy"
7. "Non-urgent signposting to another service"

## **2. General implementation guidance changes**

Section 2.2 added to general implementation guidance to reflect updated versioning methodology at PRSB.

### *"2.2 Version Numbering*

*PRSB standards published with the detailed implementation guidance in the information model use a 3-segment version number, e.g. V3.01.02, while older standards published before the detailed implementation guidance was put into the information model retain the previous 2-segment version number, e.g. V2.02 until their next maintenance release or revision.*

*2-segment version numbers take the form of major version.minor version, e.g. V2.02 where the information model is major version 2 and minor version 01.*

*3-segment version numbers use the format Va.bb.cc where:*

*a - is the major version number of the information model, incremented on significant revisions or enhancement of the information model*

*bb – is the minor version number of the information model, incremented on minor updates such as changes or issue resolutions*

*cc – is the implementation guidance version number, incremented whenever the implementation guidance is updated, which can be with or independent from an information model update. At a major revision of the information model this will restart at version 01."*
