

Community Pharmacy Use Case: Contraception Monitoring



Sarah is a 30-year-old woman who has been using the combined oral contraceptive pill for three years.

She can now have her routine contraception check-up at the pharmacy, thus saving a visit to the GP.



Alison Taylor, the community pharmacist, sees Sarah in the consulting room, takes her **blood pressure** and does the standard contraception risk **assessment** with Sarah, listening to any concerns that Sarah has.



No problems or issues are identified.

The pharmacist **supplies** the contraceptive pill.

The consultation details and the supply are **recorded** on the pharmacy system.



Sarah **consents** to her information being shared, and details of the contraception monitoring consultation and supply of the contraceptive pill are **transferred** to the GP.
